To increase transparency and trust.

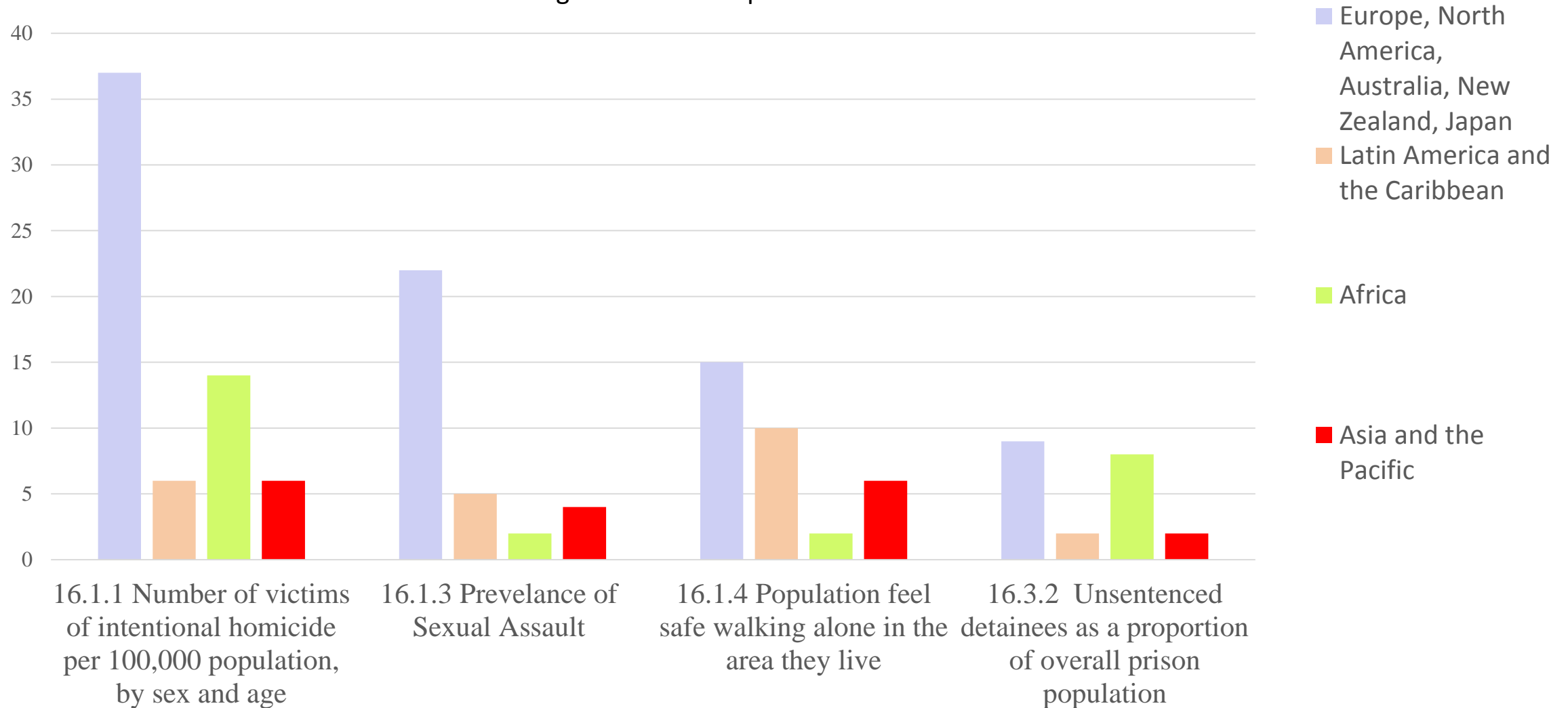
To create accurate resource allocation.

Countries submitting at least 1 data point 2010-2017 – SDG16 Metadata

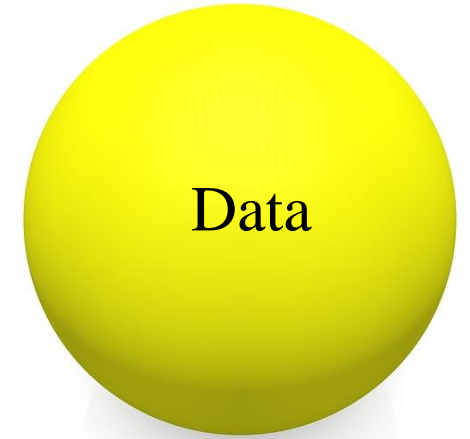


Data Gaps - CTS data

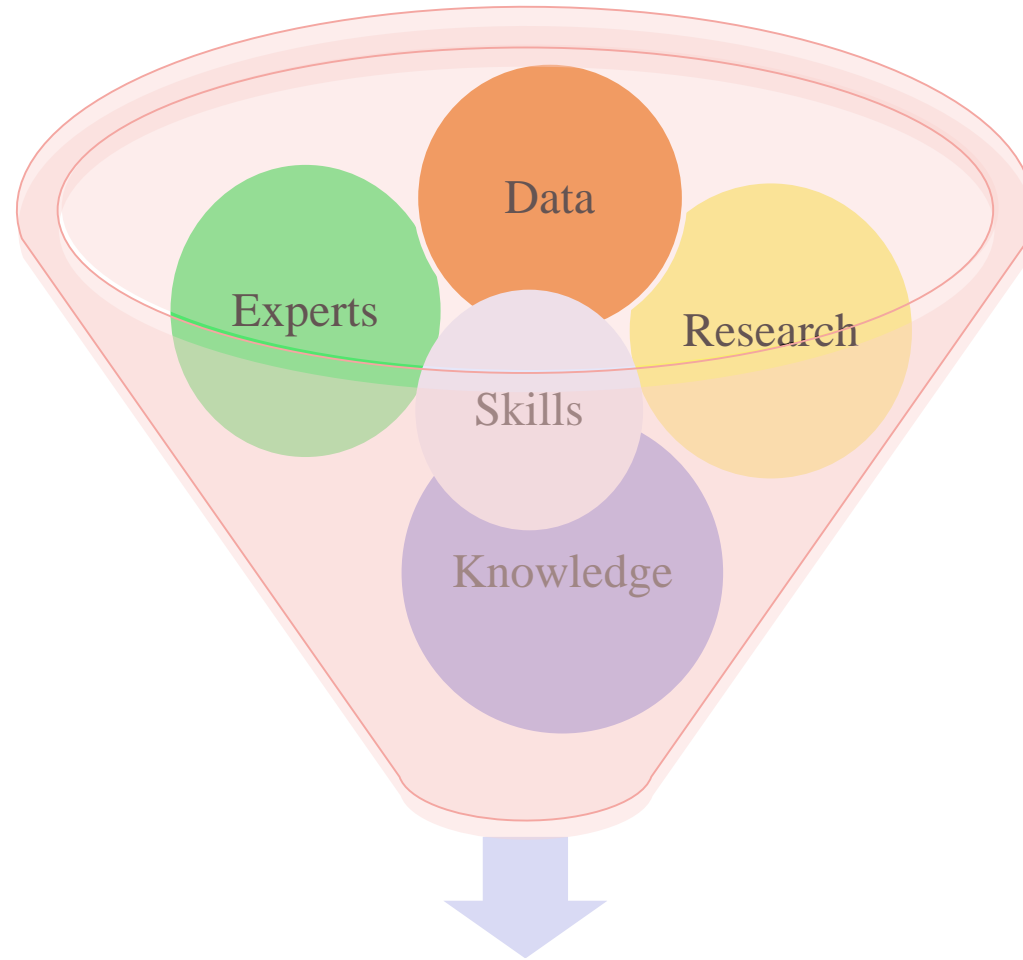
Regional Advisory Group
